 B - Breakfast
 A - AM snack
 L - Lunch
 P - PM snack
 D - Dinner
 E - Evening snack
MM - Minute menus, also referred to as scan forms, bubbles or dots
OJ - Orange Juice
OSPI - Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, our overseeing agency
P - Provider
PB - Peanut-butter
PO - Provider's own children
T/A - Technical Assistance, also referred to as provider training
USDA - United States Department of Agriculture
W/E - Weekend
X-TRA - Extra to indicate that extra meat/meat alternate was added to a menu item
